

## **Biomedical Accuracy**

The *Positive Prevention PLUS* curriculum underwent two medical reviews by staff from the federal Office of Adolescent Health in 2011 and 2014 ("Medical Accuracy Review Form for Curricula and Educational Materials Proposed for Use by Teen Pregnancy Prevention (TPP) Grantees and Personal Responsibility Education Innovative Strategies (PREIS) Grantees"), and was deemed "Meets the definition of medical accuracy with modifications" which were then made by the publisher.

A more recent review for medical accuracy was conducted in September 2019 by Adagio Health, a federal grant recipient in Pennsylvania. The curriculum was deemed by the reviewers as "medically accurate with modifications," which have also since then been made.

NOTE: Recipients of federal funding are typically required to submit their curriculum and associated materials for a biomedical review. The publishers of *Positive Prevention PLUS* welcome the review, and will gladly make recommended updates.
