2. Students can login once they navigate to your school's branch URL (web address). The Username for all students is their email address.



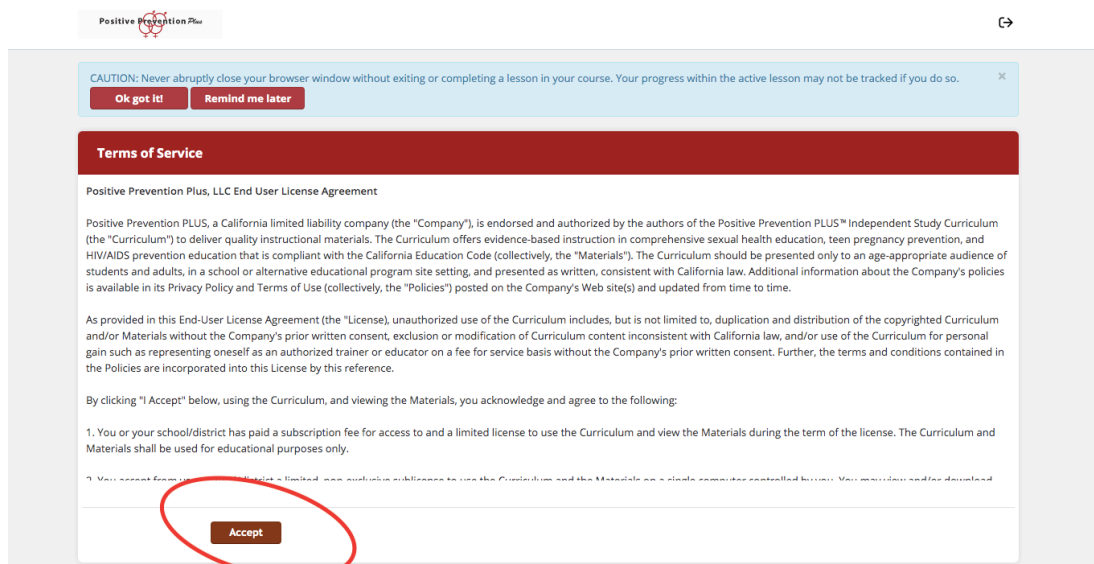

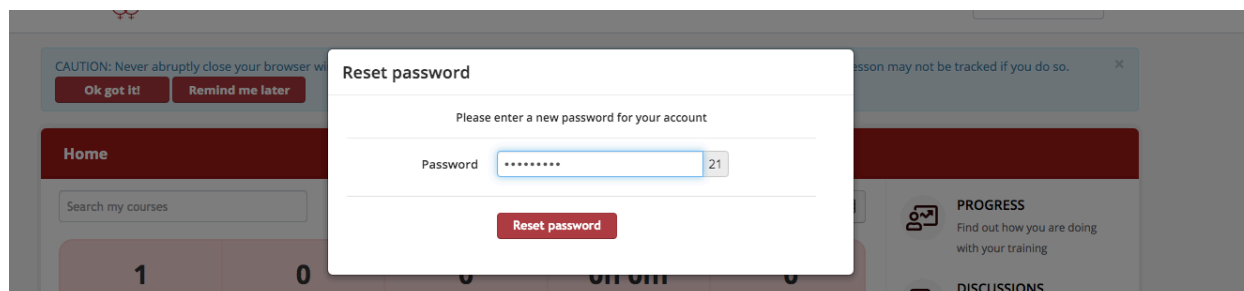

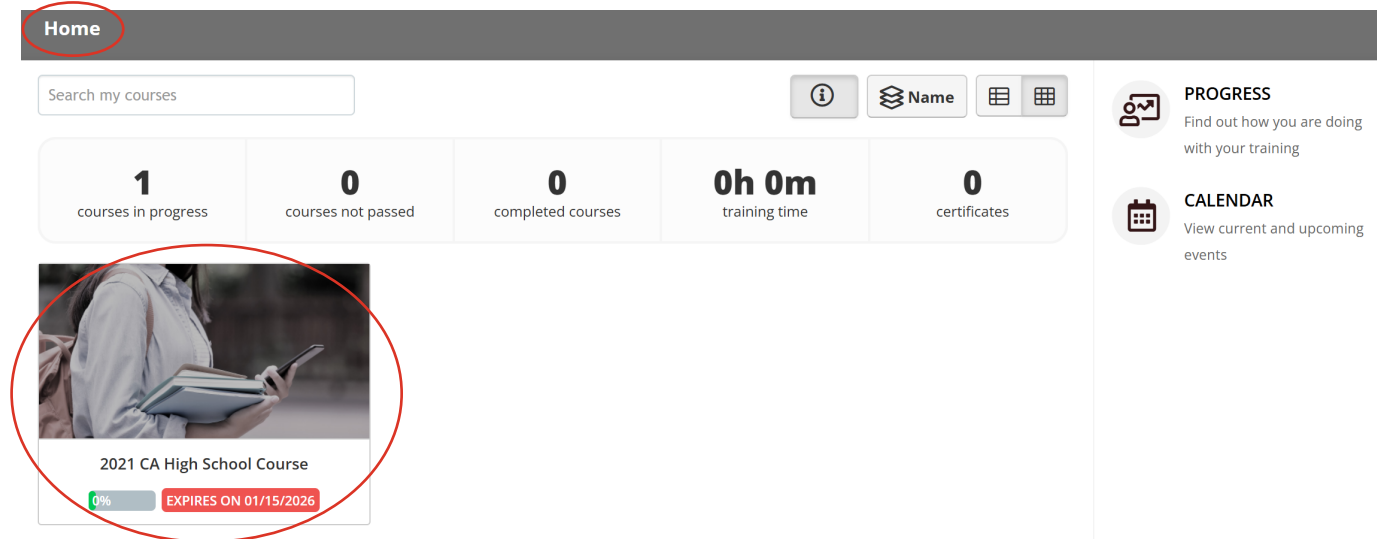
3. Once logged in, the student will see our Terms of Service page. They will need to click **Accept** at the bottom of the screen to proceed.



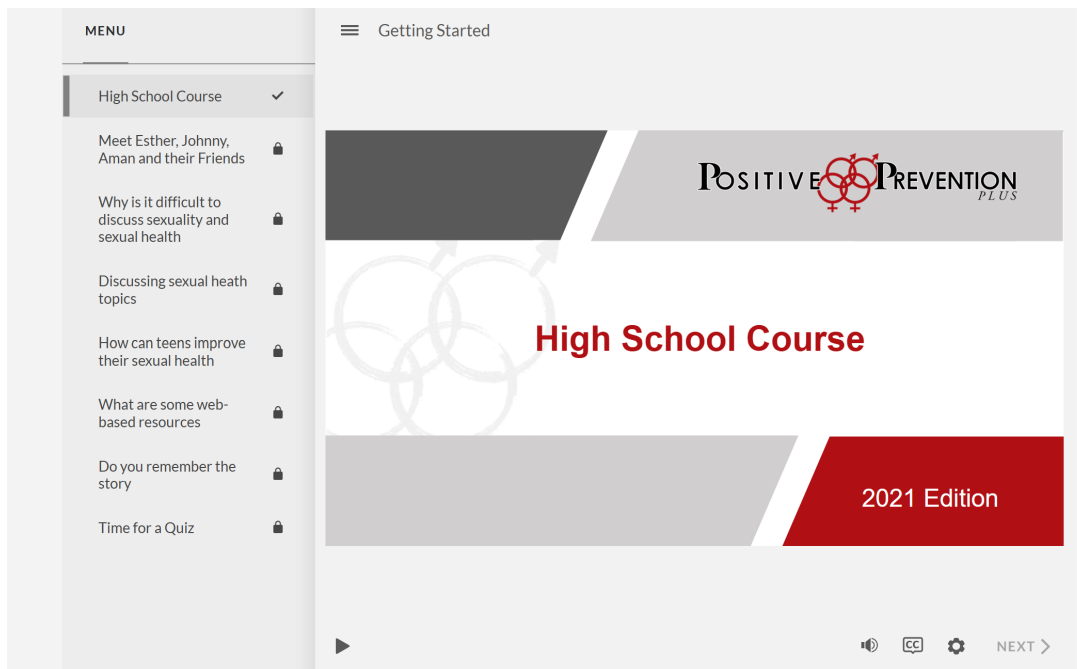
4. The next screen will direct the student to reset their password. The original password is temporary.



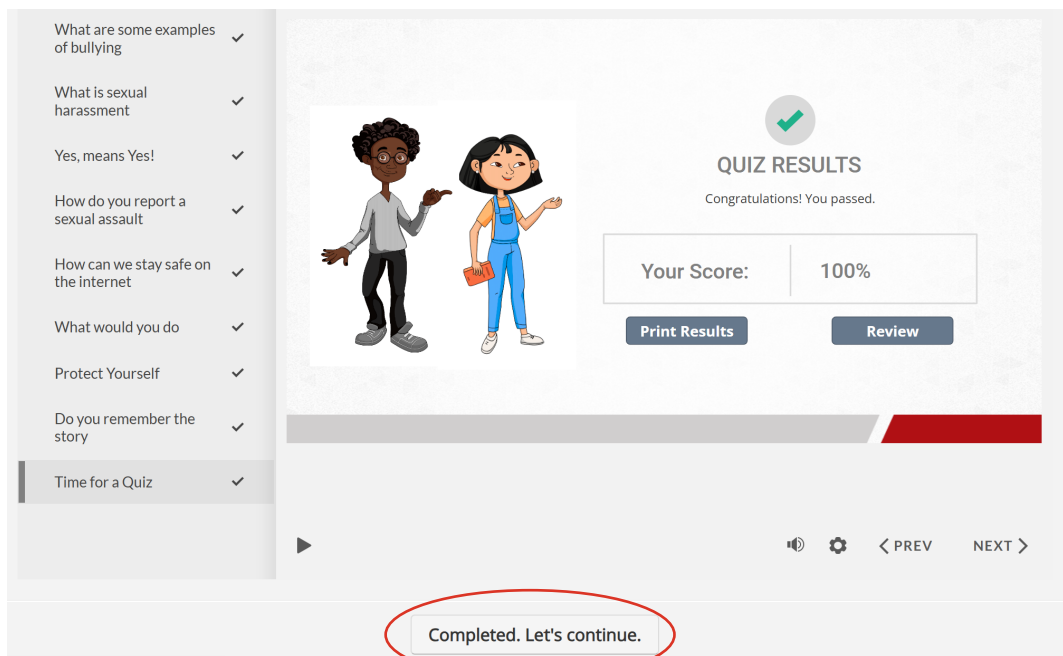
5. The student is ready to access the course. The Home page allows access to course content, progress, and the expiration date for the course. To start the course the learner will need to click on the name or the picture of the course.
